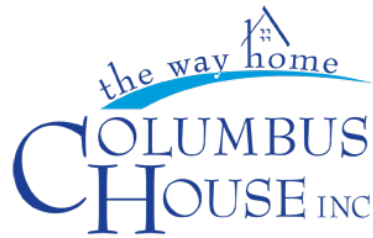

Groundbreaking Celebration for Veteran Housing in Middletown

The cold, wet morning didn't dampen the spirits of the 60 friends, supporters, partners, and Veterans who gathered to celebrate the groundbreaking of Shepherd Home on April 4th. With the help of many wonderful partners, Columbus House has begun the transformation of this historic 1920's nurses' quarters into 32 units of permanent supportive housing with a preference for Veterans.

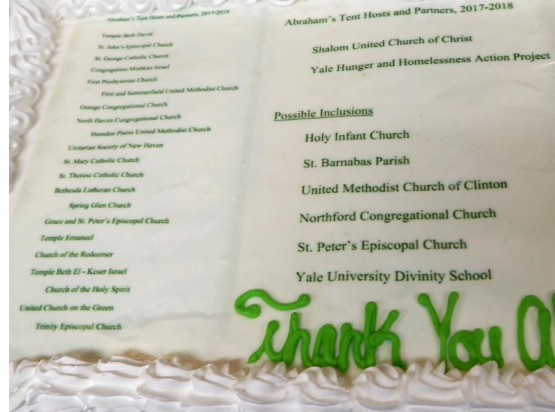


Cold Weather Shelters Coming to a Close

Columbus House offers three seasonal programs to accommodate those seeking shelter during the colder months: the New Haven Men's Overflow Shelter, the co-ed Wallingford Emergency Shelter (WES), and Abraham's Tent (AT). Overflow and WES open their doors in mid-November, and can shelter 75 and 17 people per night, respectively. AT begins in December, with different religious groups hosting up to 12 men for a week at a time, providing meals, fellowship, and camaraderie.

These programs rely heavily on the help of volunteers and religious organizations who readied the seasonal shelters, cooked and served warm meals, gave welcoming smiles and provided safe and stable accommodations. We are grateful to everyone who helped our neighbors during the coldest and darkest time of the year. We are happy to report that one man from AT is already in his own home and five more have their housing certificates in hand!

This year, WES will close on April 15th, and the New Haven Men's Seasonal Overflow Shelter will close on April 30th.

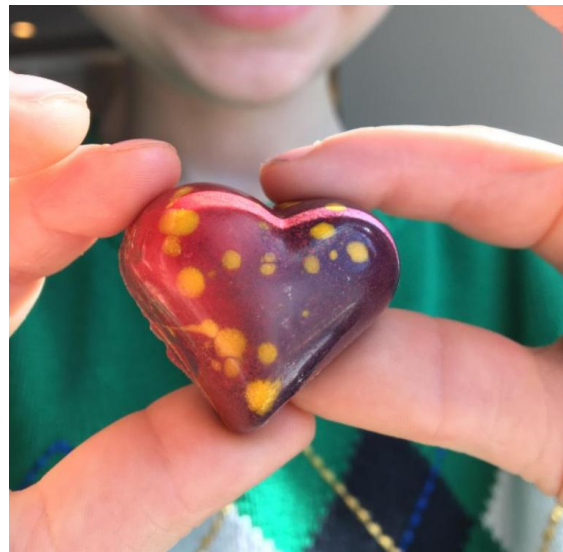


On March 25th, a dinner was held to celebrate the dedication of the religious groups that host Abraham's Tent

We would like to express our deepest gratitude to the almost 200 guests who joined us at the Inn at Middletown for the 16th annual Chocolate to the Rescue event! We raised close to \$16,000 to benefit our Middlesex Family Shelter, including over \$1,100 for Welcome Kits – basic necessities for those moving into permanent homes. Everyone involved – participants, guests, judges, emcee Jim Masters, volunteers, musician, photographers, silent auction and wine donors, and sponsors – makes our work to end homelessness for families with children in Middlesex County possible.
