The Wallingford Emergency Shelter (WES), a program of Columbus House, has four units of housing that serve as temporary, emergency shelter for **families experiencing homelessness** or those who are at imminent risk of becoming homeless and is open year-round. Three are reserved for Wallingford families and the fourth is exclusively for a Veteran family.

WES also consists of a **Seasonal Emergency Shelter** for up to 16 women and men per night during the coldest months of the year. Between November '17 and April '18, the Wallingford Emergency Shelter provided safety and support services to approximately 50 people experiencing homelessness.
