Thanks to you, since March 15 we have housed 259 people! We continue to provide life-saving services to our clients and are making connections to those living outside through the Drop-In Center. Although we are not yet reinstating volunteer service at any of our shelters, you can still volunteer at the Drop-In Center located in the back parking lot of our Boulevard location.

Volunteers should be able to stand for two hours outdoors and lift up to 25 lbs. To limit the risk to volunteers, all volunteers must be under the age of 60 and should not have any underlying health conditions. Opportunities to volunteer in 2.5 hour shifts are available Monday-Friday (noon-4:30 pm).
